Lieberman selects from an array of projects to curate and bring Code Poetics to life. "I've always been interested in the idea of code being poetry, making art projects using software and language. His edition on Dream The End will include works from: Arturo Castro, Chris Sugrue, Cory Arcangel, Julien Maire, and rANdom International who is currently showing Rain Room at the MoMA.

Lieberman explains that making art through code is slowly making its way into museums and the art society. "We are now entering museums as software designers, and the pieces we are creating are looked at as a form of design versus art, but we are certainly making our way and pushing the boundaries for people to see how code is art," expresses Lieberman.

After having an open call for a submissions edition last month, Dream The End is exploring and exposing new and different genres of art. Code Poetics is the first to showcase the art of coding.
